I am requesting funding for The Learning Commons: Space for Learning, Meeting and Collaboration Project in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is Burlington County, located at 49 Rancocas Road, Mount Holly, NJ 08060. The funding would be used to redesign and refurbish the Burlington County Library and build a new multi-purpose area to provide equitable opportunities for personal improvement and a more informed, educated, and skilled population.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will transform underutilized space at the flagship Burlington County Library into a state-of-the-art Learning Commons that provides free, equitable access to technology, educational programming, and collaborative spaces—benefiting over 460,000 residents, particularly low- and middle-income families, students, and small business owners, and supporting economic, educational, and civic advancement across the region.
