I am requesting funding for the Freehold Borough Water Tower Tanks Refurbishment Project in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is The Borough of Freehold, located at 30 Mechanic Street, Freehold, NJ 07728.

The funding would be used to clean and reseal the Borough's two water tanks to ensure the storage and distribution of safe, reliable drinking water. This project also protects public health by safeguarding water quality and minimizing the risk of contamination.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
